INTRODUCTION

“What’s past is prologue”

In my Author’s Preface I reveal the (true) story that unfolds in this book takes place during 1996: from early May through December. Yet twenty or more years on these pages will be read in a world so radically different (geopolitically, economically, technologically) from when they were experienced. That is an oddity considering 20 years (two decades) can equate to just one quarter of many people’s entire lifespan.

We would do well to acknowledge, from the outset, that such concentrated and multi-faceted change is simply not a natural phenomenon. Change of such breadth, depth, and scope can hardly be natural. Short of a catastrophe (e.g., major earthquake) or violent upheaval (widespread war, civil disorder, etc.), or total economic dissolution (a new monetary system) ... a divergence of such magnitude compressed into just two decades can only be a consequence of man’s (i.e., our so-called Elite’s) intervention. Or to put it more starkly, *someone’s “not so hidden” agenda has been played out, or pushed through.*

To flesh out this thesis a little, and before commencing this book’s core narrative, I would like to hold your attention here for an extended period. After visiting 24 very different nations, and working in 9 of those, I think I have earned the right to offer opinions and insights that push the envelope a little. I have a habit of diverging strongly from what most might loosely call *received wisdom*. If a book cannot at least challenge opinions or pre-conceived ideas then why read it?

Increasingly, we see the terms ‘matrix’ and ‘hologram’ used to frame the dissimulation and artificiality that describes or sums

up, the world of deception that has been constructed around us.

If you crave information that might help you peer through the haze of that falsity and deception—to identify some of the trans-generational organizations and institutions whose entire credo is parasitic hegemony—then you will surely enjoy this Introduction.

While researching and writing this book I have come to view the 1990s in a far darker light than I actually lived it. It would seem there is a great deal that was put in motion, planted, or initiated back in that transitional decade. While they were “in-play” we failed to identify those stealthy activities as a threat. Consequently, little or no ‘bud-nipping’ was attempted. Big mistake.

Sagacity brings into murky focus an immensely powerful yet atomized group, communicating secretly or even in plain sight while pretending to do or be something else. They (an amorphous grouping of plotters) appear to have used the 1990s to launch several disturbing initiatives whose ugly fruits were intended to feed all of the violence, destruction of nation states, financial fraud, and ecological vandalism witnessed during our third millennium’s first two decades. If you believe the news headlines from that 1990s decade reflect a natural evolution or some rational management of human affairs, then please think again! You are having your strings pulled.

Old templates are sometimes the most helpful. Those trained in the art of espionage see life differently. A fifteen to twenty year subversion cycle is what Soviet Communism always worked with. I have in mind G. Edward Griffin’s shocking 1984 interview of ex-KGB officer and Soviet defector Yuri Bezmenov. Conspiracy researchers, especially the adepts, can readily trace back the origins of this or that malign influence to the days of the

Roman Empire, to Biblical times, or even back to Babylon and Sumer. Or perhaps further, to that mythical time before “The Flood”: an hypothesis supported by significant yet perplexing archaeological evidence! Don’t worry; my back tracing (my retrospection) is very modest in comparison.

The core story of my book begins and ends in 1996. But the context in which that year actually played out is rooted in the 1989 to 1991 period. And that year’s repercussions continued to ripple forwards until September of 2001. During 1996 I can still remember being fixated on the events of 1990-95; an especially transformative period, as I am about to demonstrate.

What worsened my experience of 1996 was that I had just lived through six relatively sheltered years. After emerging from my academic cocoon (May 1996) I became exposed to the raw, howling winds of change, but not “change for the better”. These winds carried a stench. I sensed early that much was not ‘smelling’ right.

Despite the widespread and tangible optimism being pumped out by the first Clinton Presidency, I was still sensing something dark and ominous. As early as 1993-94 it was obvious to me (President) William Jefferson Clinton was a rogue and an inveterate liar. His oddball wife, Hillary, a megalomaniac with an intense sex drive that was being singularly misdirected towards the pursuit of absolute power and adulation. Yet both individuals appeared too stupid to have authored anything original. So who or what were they both fronting for? Meanwhile, unseen people were rearranging the scenery at the back of the global stage. They were up to something; something very big. And that something was NOT for your or my benefit.

The entirety of the many changes foisted upon our known world went far beyond the collapse of the Berlin Wall (9 November 1989), the creation of the World Wide Web concept (Tim Berners-Lee, 6 August 1991), and the development of the Mosaic (First) Web browser (by Marc Andreessen, University of Illinois, which in turn spurred a 341,000% growth in Internet
